Special Tribute Honoring the 50th Season of "60 Minutes"

New York, N.Y. – October 5, 2017 – Winners of the 38th Annual News and Documentary Emmy® Awards were announced tonight by the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences (NATAS). The News & Documentary Emmy® Awards were presented at a ceremony at Jazz at Lincoln Center's Frederick P. Rose Hall in New York City.

"It is with great pleasure that the National Academy honors the men and women of the television news and documentary industry who provide us with the in-depth coverage and analysis of events that affect our lives and those around the globe," said Chuck Dages, Chairman, NATAS.

"I can't think of a time in our recent history when the need for clear and factual reporting was more paramount," said Bob Mauro, President & CEO, NATAS. "Tonight, we honor those who are steadfast in their belief that an informed electorate is the cornerstone of our great democracy."

The event was attended by more than 1,000 television and news media industry executives, news and documentary producers and journalists. Emmy® Awards were presented in 49 categories.

Legendary anchor Charles Osgood was honored for his almost 50 years in radio and television, including his many years hosting, "CBS Sunday Morning." The lifetime achievement award was presented by past President of NBC News, former Washington Bureau Chief for CBS News, and past Chairman of the News & Documentary Emmy Awards, Bill Small.

In addition, a special tribute honoring the 50th anniversary of the CBS' news program, "60 Minutes" was introduced by current Executive Producer, Jeff Fager.
